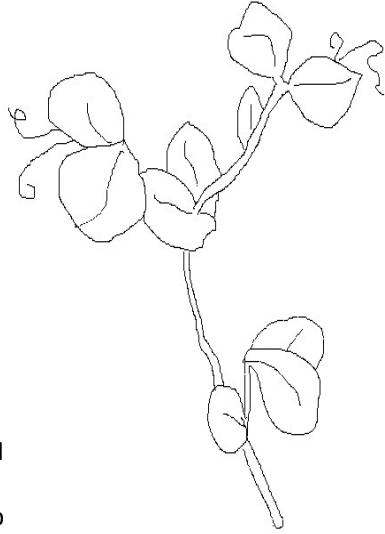


Pea Shoots

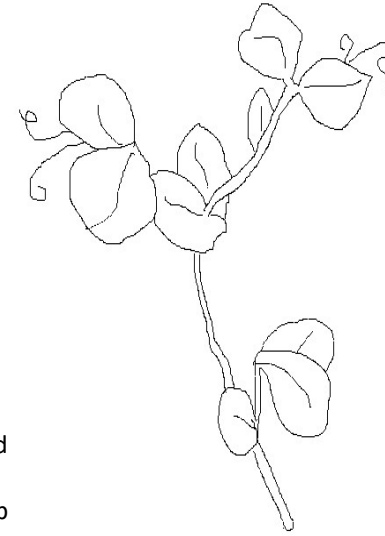
We have sent them home unwatered to reduce mud in the school bag! So please water them at home and keep them on a bright windowledge.

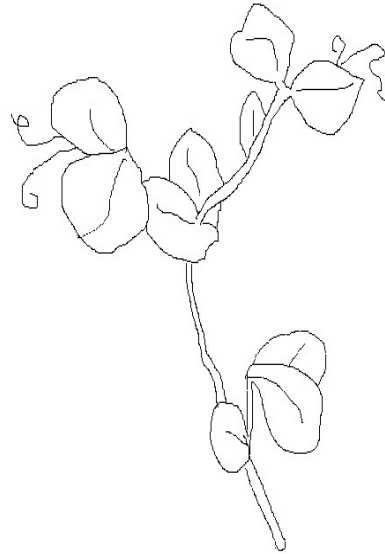
